The school has a full-time chaplain, Mrs James, who warmly welcomes you to Cardinal Newman.

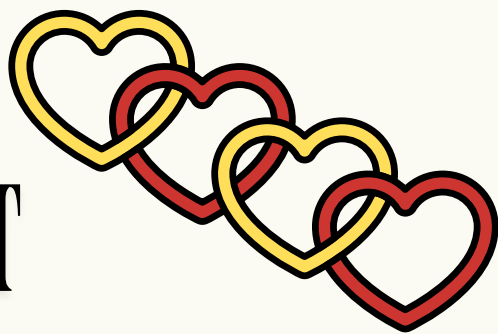
