2. National Careers Service

Exam Results Helpline

The National Careers Service will be delivering the Exam Results Helpline in August to provide careers information and advice to young people, parents and carers following receipt of their teacher assessed grades for GCSE, AS and A level and vocational qualifications.

The helpline will open on Monday August 9, and will be available until Friday 27 August from 8 am to 8 pm Monday to Friday and 10 am to 5 pm on Saturday. This will be supported by a dedicated landing page on the National Careers Service website, automated webchat and messages to help route telephone calls. Supporting communications activity will include signposting to immediate next steps and choices, using social media, short videos, case studies, and spotlights on technical routes and pathways.

The helpline number is the regular 0800 100 900 number, and any calls about results will be channelled via the interactive voice response (IVR) system. Options will include

- Want help and advice after receiving the teachers assessed grades
- Speak to an adviser in their local area
- Direct customers to UCAS Clearing if about university options,
- The website landing page for information on resits or appeals

3. New Leaf

The New Leaf programme supports people aged 16 or over in Cheshire and Warrington who are out of work and need extra help to get into work or to get back into education or training.
