Addendum to the Behaviour Policy during COVID-19

This update should be seen in addition to the existing school behaviour policy

- Students must follow social distancing rules and when moving around the school or in the classroom must remain 2m apart
- Students when travelling on school transport and moving around school must wear a face covering
- Students will be allocated a specific zone. Each zone will have a designated entrance and exit. Students will not be allowed to wander around the school site and must remain in their zone.
- Students will be expected to follow school instructions on personal hygiene, including the advice given on handwashing and hand sanitising
- Students will be expected to clean their hands after sneezing or coughing
- Students will be reminded to catch coughs and sneezes through the UK Government's 'catch it, bin it, kill it' approach.
- Students must dispose of tissues in the lidded pedal bin provided in each classroom.
- Students must report to adult staff if they feel unwell or are experiencing symptoms of coronavirus. They must not return to school until they have been tested and confirmed as negative. If they are confirmed as positive, they must isolate along with their "bubble group" for a minimum of 14 days.
- Students will not be allowed to share equipment other than that provided in the classroom for their class
- Students must not access areas of the school beyond their allocated spaces
- Students must not go up to the member of staff's desk to ask for help but remain in their allocated seat and raise their hand and be supported utilising social distancing measures
- Students to follow the school behaviour policy and any student making poor choices will be dealt with appropriately
- Any student not following the class teachers' expectations will be asked to stand outside the classroom and will be picked up by a member of SLT and dealt with appropriately.
- If a child persistently misbehaves and poses a risk to staff or fellow students, then a phone call will be made for parents/ carers to collect their child from school.
- Students who purposely cough or spit at other children or staff will be excluded from the school. This is to safeguard the other students and staff working at the school. A return to school meeting will take place with the Headteacher.
